

Khader Adnan

Khader Adnan is a former leader of the Palestinian Islamic Jihad (PIJ), an internationally recognized terrorist organization that carries out attacks against civilians and calls for the genocide of Jews and the destruction of Israel.

Khader Adnan incites violence against Jews, openly encouraging and glorifying suicide bombings.

- At a PIJ member's funeral, Adnan called on his partners to murder Jews by blowing themselves up.
 - He shouted, "O Quds Brigades, Strike a blow! O Quds Brigades, Shake the earth! Who among you is Hasan Abu Zeid? **Who among you is the next suicide bomber?** Who among you will carry the next explosive belt? Who among you will fire the next bullets? **Who among you will have his body parts blown all over?**"¹

The Palestinian Islamic Jihad carries out terror attacks against Israeli civilians to accomplish its main goal of annihilating Israel and establishing an Islamic state in what it calls "all of historic Palestine."²

- The PIJ has received most of its funding from Iran, the world's largest state sponsor of terror.³
- The PIJ has carried out dozens of suicide bombings against civilians in Israel since 2000.⁴
 - Here are just a few examples of the group's terrorist attacks:⁵
 - The PIJ murdered three civilians with a suicide attack in an Eilat bakery in 2007.
 - A PIJ suicide bomber slaughtered twenty-one civilians in a Tel Aviv nightclub in 2001.
 - At a restaurant in Haifa, a PIJ suicide bomber murdered 22 people and injured 60 in 2003.
 - A PIJ suicide bomber killed 11 civilians in a Tel Aviv restaurant in 2006.
- The PIJ opposes any peace and negotiations with Israel.
 - To the PIJ, peaceful coexistence is not an option. It calls for the total **annihilation of the Jewish state through strictly violent means.**⁶
 - **Adnan asserts that all Palestinian-Arab groups should carry out terrorist attacks against Israeli civilians.**⁷
